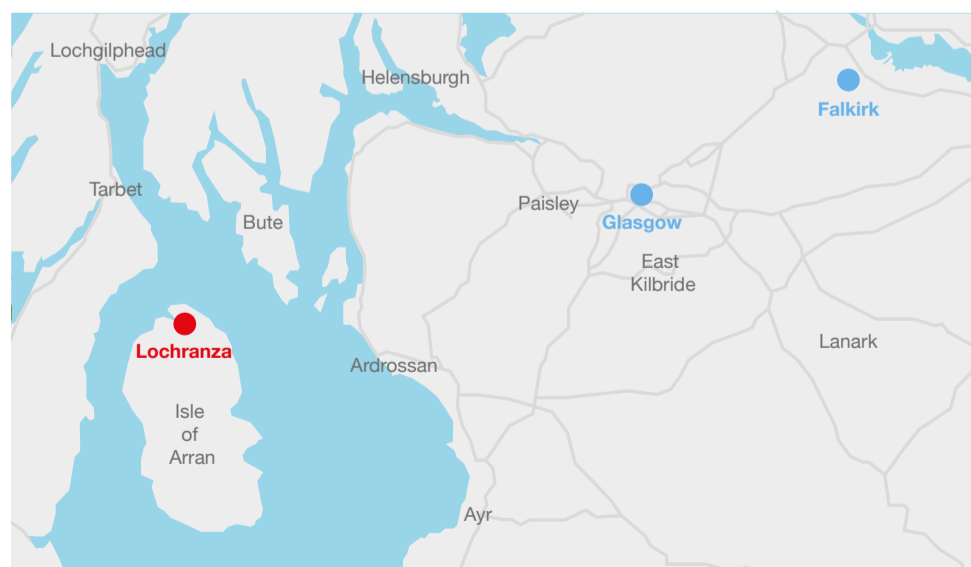
At Lochranza Centre we realise that a school trip away from home can provide a lot of educational opportunities.
