Contact with domestic animals injury or illness caused by cattle	Cattle are often grazed on the Coastal Way footpath. Instructor briefs group and leads them past the cattle. Participants behave in a calm and quiet manner. Participants never deliberately walk between a nursing mother and her calf.	3x2 = 6		
Injury caused by slips, trips and falls on difficult terrain; steep & unstable path at Dun Fionn fort (Arran Coastal Way)	Students briefed on the hazards and instructor spots guests at significant obstacles. The short section of path from the coll up to Dun Fionn will only be used if the group is small, the condition of the path is known and weather conditions are suitable. In wet and muddy conditions the path will not be used.	3x2 = 6		
Injury caused by barbed wire or electric fence.	Group to be briefed on potential hazards. Instructor remains vigilant at all times.	2x1 = 2		
Free time: Injury or illness caused by individuals becoming separated from the rest of the group.	Students to remain in groups of 3 or more at all times. Students shown location of meeting points and know time of meeting. Method of communication to be prepared and one member of each group of students should have a mobile phone.	3x1 = 3
