Descending group stop for vehicles and pass pedestrians and animals at a safe and considerate speed.	3x2 = 6		
Steep descent down Whins Track	Participants briefed on hazards and monitored by instructors as per training and MOS. Instructor leads decent and participants follow at intervals in a safe and controlled manner.	3x2 = 6		
Small stream Crossings	Participants briefed on dangers and monitored by instructors. If streams too full to cross safely participants walk mountain bikes over the footbridge.	2x2 = 4
