Extreme Weather	Instructor to be aware, guests to wear appropriate clothing & where required appropriate procedures carried out in line with site specific training	2 x 2 = 4		
Falling tree debris	Arboreal Management inc. inspections. Evacuate all areas under tree canopy if wind rises above Beaufort scale 7+ (Near gale; 51-62 km/h; 28-33 knots; Whole trees in motion; inconvenience when walking against wind.	4 x 1 = 4		
Equipment Failure	Regular Periodic inspection of equipment by appropriate person . Instructor PPE & equipment checks each session. Max user numbers set by centre.	3 x 1 = 3		
Injury due to incorrect footwear and or clothing	Group leaders and Instructors to ensure guests are appropriately clothed to the minimum operating standards and the prevailing weather conditions.	3 x 1 = 3		
Entrapment of hair, fingers, loose clothing, jewellery, in equipment, etc	Hair tied/ tucked back. Loose clothing removed or made safe. Jewellery removed or made safe where not possible to be removed. Instructor awareness & supervision. Guests briefed on risk & hazards of activities equipment.	3 x 1 = 3		
Slips/Trips	Instructor vigilance & making guests aware of hazards in the environment	3 x 2 = 6		
Dehydration	Instructor to ensure group have drinks with them during hot weather especially if outside. Instructors responsible for themselves	2 x 2 = 4
