Free time: Injury or illness caused by individuals becoming separated from the rest of the group.	Students to remain in groups of 3 or more at all times. Students shown location of meeting points and know time of meeting. Method of communication to be prepared and one member of each group of students should have a mobile phone.	3x1 = 3		
Group work; Injury or illness by completing tasks unsupervised.	Group only to complete unsupervised tasks if deemed appropriate in conjunction with accompanying adult. Instructor to remain in visual contact with group. Students to stay in groups of 3 minimum; to be clearly briefed on boundaries and timings. Head count to be carried out when group is back together.	3x1 = 3		
Unplanned departure from route; Injury or illness caused by consequences of being unable to return to route.	In each village a clearly defined point is used as the termination of each transect; this location is clearly given to all instructors, visiting staff and the bus driver. Instructor to be trained to navigate to return to route using map. Map of area to be carried by every instructor in tutor sack. Instructor to remain vigilant. Group to be dressed appropriately for current and forecast weather conditions. Method of communication to be prepared (mobile phone) according to MOS.	2x1 = 2
